Dileep Gangolli is an active clarinet teacher and performer in the Chicago area. Currently on the faculty of the Midwest Young Artists and the Illinois Woodwind Academy, he has previously taught at North Park University and the VanderCook College of Music. He is a member of the Chicago Sinfonietta, the Lake Forest Symphony Orchestra, and the Joffrey Ballet Orchestra. Mr. Gangolli holds degrees from Northwestern University, Southern Methodist University, and the University of Washington. His principal teachers include Robert Marcellus, Anthony Gigliotti, and Ronald Phillips. In 1986 he was awarded a Fulbright Scholarship for study in the United Kingdom.
